INFORMATION TO THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIONS

Subject: Adaptation of allowances of seconded national experts

Your Excellency,

According to Article 17(5) of Commission Decision C(2008) 6866 of 12.11.2008 laying down the rules on the secondment to the Commission of national experts and national experts in professional training, adjustments to the remuneration adopted pursuant to Article 65 of the Staff Regulations shall apply automatically to the subsistence allowances in the month following their adoption.

Pursuant to Article 65 of the Staff Regulations, the officials' and other agents' remuneration and pensions were updated in December 2022¹.

I would like to inform you that the allowances to be paid by the Commission to seconded national experts in line with Article 17(1) of aforementioned Decision have been adjusted as follows **as from 1st of January 2023**:

- a) Daily allowance: **157,35 €**
- b) Monthly allowance based on the distance between the place of origin and place of secondment:

For your convenience, please find attached an updated table with the most frequent distance calculations and the corresponding monthly allowance.

The correction coefficients applied to the subsistence allowances for seconded national experts based outside of Belgium or Luxemburg are also updated as from 1 January 2023.
